I am the volunteer coordinator for the Denver Fisher House Board of Directors. I read your profile on the Metro Volunteers Board Leadership Connection program and was interested in talking with you about our organization and your possible interest in joining our commitment to our veterans and their families.

The Zachary and Elizabeth Fisher House, operated by the Denver VAMC, is a “comfort home” for active duty and veteran families who are receiving medical treatment at a nearby medical facility. There is no charge to our guests who stay at the house temporarily while receiving their treatment.

The Denver Fisher House is a 9-room facility located at the Fitzsimons campus. We are currently recruiting for board members who have the following expertise: fundraising, legal, outreach, and volunteer management.

The board of directors meets the 2nd Tuesday of every month and the meeting lasts roughly one and a half hours. Besides the board of directors meetings, some of the sub-committees meet throughout the month as needed and there are special events that occur throughout the year.
